Tual State Fisheries of Polytechnic (POLIKANT), located in the Kei Islands, Maluku, has been given the responsibility to develop and support suitable programs that will help Indonesia improving its market standing in the marine sector. As concrete approach Polikant organized MSFT International Conference to focus on providing access to the latest research and technology to accelerate the development of sustainable marine and fisheries activities, and will focus on coastal areas which have the greatest potential for economic growth.

ABOUT KEI ISLANDS & ACCOMODATION

The islands are on the edge of the Banda Sea, south of the Bird's Head Peninsula of New Guinea, west of the Aru Islands, and northeast of the Tanimbar Islands. The small group called Tayandu Islands (also Tahayad) is just west.. Technically two cities on two islands, Tual on Dullah and Langgur on Kei Kecil are in fact joined by a 300 meter bridge, connected by the city public transportation that runs right through from one to the other, and between them share the Kei Islands main port (in Tual) and airport (in Langgur). As such, they really form a single practical unit that should be treated as one. The two cities have pretty much everything visitors might need in such as supermarkets, internet cafes, travel agencies and a range of accommodation.
